



ABILENE, TX -- An 89-year-old man was killed yesterday after hitting another car from behind. According to the Texas Department of Public Safety, on August 27 at 3:39 p.m., the Texas Department of Public Safety responded to a major motor vehicle accident on FM 89, one mile south of Abilene.

When they arrived they found Marvin Guelker, 89, of Buffalo Gap who had suffered major injuries. He was transported to the Abilene Regional Medical Center where he later died. His body was taken to North's Funeral Home. The other driver, Sabrina Kirk, 52, was taken to the ARMC and was later released.

After further investigation, the trooper determined that Kirk was stopped in the southbound lane of FM 89 attempting to make a left turn onto CR 338. Guelker's vehicle was also traveling South and struck Kirk's car from behind. No arrests have been made at this time.
