These directions are provided by Pat O'Brien---Address is 3577 E. Friendship Rd., Springdale, AR 72764. Google Maps has it at 110 miles/ 2 hours from the Golden Corral on 71th Street, Tulsa. 2 hours and 20 minutes would be a reasonable driving time if you use the Cherokee Turnpike (US 412). My sources list the 3-axle cost for that turnpike at \$3.75. As you come into Springdale, AR, continue on US 412 to the east side of the city. Turn left (north at the light) on Butterfield Coach Rd. (for ½ mile), then turn right (east at the light) at Friendship Rd. (for 1/4 of a mile) into a driveway on the right. The driveway has two black posts on either side of the driveway entrance. Theirs is a two-story colonial house. It is somewhat of a tight turn---
